

A Prayer for January

from the Desk of Dr. Carol E. Dixon



Here are prayer points for Divine Expansion and increase you can use to pray.

God wants you to grow, increase and multiply way more than you can imagine and may even dream of.

He's a good God.

He does exceeding abundantly above all you can ever imagine and think-Ephesians 3:20, KJV.

But you know, like every other provision in Christ, Divine Expansion and Increase have to be appropriated through bold declaration of the Word of God and then through
PRAYER.

You will have to **CONFESS** your Divine Expansion and Increase, then you will have to **PRAY** it to being.

Well, to give you a head start for you to get going, I have put together this list of prayer points for Divine Expansion and Increase for your easy reach and reference.

Now let's get to praying.....

Ready!

1. Pray and ask God to pour upon you the Spirit of Increase, Expansion, and Multiplication, in Jesus name.

“Until the Spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest”. (Isaiah 32:15, KJV)

2. Pray and ask the Lord to anoint you for Divine Expansion and Increase and Multiplication such that anything you touch will have no choice than to prosper, in Jesus name.

3. Pray and ask the Lord to anoint your hands with the Midas touch anointing, such that whatever you touch will grow and multiply abundantly, in Jesus name.

And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. (Psalm 1:3, KJV)

4. Pray and ask the Lord to increase His life in you that anything dead that you touch will receive life and grow to become mighty, in Jesus name.

5. Pray and ask the Lord to bless you with grace that makes and takes things from little to much, from small to big, from grass to grace, and from glory to glory, in Jesus name.

A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation: I the LORD will hasten it in his time. (Isaiah 60:22, KJV)

6. Pray and declare that by the Spirit of the Lord, you are experiencing increase and multiplication in all areas of your life, in Jesus name.

7. Pray and declare that all your ventures are multiplying and growing, in Jesus name.

Joseph is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well; whose branches run over the wall. (Genesis 49:22, KJV)

8. Pray and declare that the fruit of your body is multiplying and increasing, in Jesus name.

9. Pray and declare that the fruit of your mind (your brain children) are growing and multiplying, in Jesus name.

Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep. (Deuteronomy 28:4, KJV)

10. Pray and declare that all your investments and businesses are growing and multiplying by the Spirit of the Lord and by the wisdom of Christ, in Jesus name.

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing. (Psalm 92:12-14, KJV)

11. Pray and declare that you are walking in favor, power and miracles every day, in Jesus name.
LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong..... (Psalm 30:7, KJV)

12. Pray and declare that the grace of God is abundant on you for Divine expansion, multiplication and increase, in Jesus name.
Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever. (Psalm 45:2, KJV)

13. Pray and declare that the wisdom of God in you is producing divine expansion, increase and multiplication in all you do, in Jesus name.

Wisdom is good with an inheritance: and by it there is profit to them that see the sun. (Ecclesiastes 7:11, KJV)

14. Pray and declare that all of your labor and work will not be in vain, but that they will all see and enjoy the dew of heaven that makes for divine expansion, increase, and multiplication, in Jesus name.

They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. (Isaiah 65:23, KJV)

15. Pray and declare that you are more than a conqueror in life; you are victorious and triumphant by the Spirit and the Word of God, in Jesus name.

Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of His knowledge by us in every place. (2 Corinthians 2:14, KJV)

16. Pray and ask the Lord to grant you the power to prosper in all things, in Jesus name.

But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day. (Deuteronomy 8:18, KJV)

17. Pray and ask the Lord to expand, multiply, and increase you by His mercy, in Jesus name.

Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee. (Psalm 33:22, KJV)

Now, go ahead and thank God for answer to prayers, in Jesus name.

Nonetheless exhaustive, these prayer points for divine expansion, increase and multiplication are intended to help you get started in prayer.

Then as you pray and begin to yield to the Holy Spirit, He will take you to realms and depths in the spirit that you never imagined reachable by you.


Then as you continue to build up in prayer, He will begin to show you the areas in your life that need adjustments so you can accommodate the divine expansion and increase that is coming – you have to experience increase first in the realm of the spirit before you can handle every other physical, material and mental increase.

Plus, the Holy Spirit will also show you, the steps you need to take, the things you need to do to birth expansion, increase and multiplication in other areas of your life.

Let the Holy Spirit help you induce growth and increase. This is made possible by yielding to Him, giving it over to Him – praying in the spirit.
